Day Service provides day care for older people.

It offers a homely therapeutic environment.

Mid-Lin aim to help and support our service users to be part of their wider community.

What is Mid-Lin Services?

The main hall caters for service users lunches and where most of our activities take place. Our small lounge is used for our weekly church service as well as some quieter activities.

How much does it cost for Service users to attend?
